

# CONSTITUTIONAL CHARTER

FOR PEACE, REGENERATION  
AND THE FLOURISHING OF HUMANITY

**Federal and Garantist Framework**

## PROEMIUM

Conscious that humanity has entered an era in which political, economic and technological powers operate on a planetary scale;

Recognizing that peace can no longer be conceived solely as the absence of war, but must be established as a structural condition of life, dignity and cooperation;

Affirming that law, in the age of technological power, must evolve from an instrument of mere defense into an architecture of human and planetary flourishing;

In continuity with the garantist constitutional tradition and in fidelity to the dignity of the human person and the integrity of the Earth;

This Constitutional Charter is proposed as a common foundation for a renewed global order oriented toward peace, regeneration and shared responsibility.

## TITLE I

### FOUNDATIONAL PRINCIPLES

#### **Article 1 – Centrality of the Human Person**

1. The human person, as a conscious, moral and responsible being, stands at the center of the constitutional order.
  2. All political, economic, scientific and technological powers are subordinated to the dignity, freedom and responsibility of the human person.

#### **Article 2 – Peace as a Constitutional Principle**

1. Peace is recognized as a foundational and organizing principle of the constitutional order.
  2. Peace is understood not merely as the absence of armed conflict, but as a stable condition enabling life, cooperation, justice and human development.

#### **Article 3 – From Sustainability to Flourishing**

1. The ultimate aim of this Charter is the integral flourishing of humanity and the Earth.

2. The paradigm of mere sustainability is surpassed by a paradigm of regeneration, growth in dignity, and qualitative development of life systems.

## **TITLE II**

### THE EARTH AND NATURAL COMMON GOODS\*\*

#### **Article 4 – The Earth as a Living Common Good**

1. The Earth, including land, seas, freshwater, air, ecosystems and biodiversity, is recognized as a living common good and a fundamental condition of life.
  2. The protection of the Earth is a constitutional duty owed to present and future generations.

#### **Article 5 – Duty of Regeneration**

1. The Federation affirms a positive constitutional duty of regeneration of the Earth and its ecosystems.
  2. Public policies, economic systems and technological infrastructures shall be oriented toward restoring, regenerating and improving environmental conditions beyond those inherited.
  3. Any activity causing irreversible damage to vital ecological cycles is incompatible with this Charter.

## **TITLE III**

### TECHNOLOGY AS CONSTITUTIONAL INFRASTRUCTURE

#### **Article 6 – Strategic Digital and Computational Technologies**

1. Digital and computational technologies, including hardware and software infrastructures, are recognized as strategic infrastructures for fundamental rights, human development and peace.
  2. Such infrastructures are protected as goods of common interest, according to principles of dignity, transparency, responsibility, pluralism and non-discrimination.

#### **Article 7 – Prohibition of Technological Domination**

1. The use of technologies as instruments of manipulation, domination, coercion, covert interference or systemic destabilization is prohibited.

2. The Federation prevents excessive concentration of technological power and infrastructural dependencies that undermine informational sovereignty and freedom.

## **Article 8 – Scientific and Technological Cooperation**

1. The Federation promotes international scientific and technological cooperation through shared infrastructures, open standards and transparent supply chains.
  2. Research and innovation shall be oriented toward the common good and peaceful coexistence.

## **TITLE IV**

### **SECURITY AND QUANTUM TECHNOLOGIES**

## **Article 9 – Technological and Post-Quantum Security**

1. Digital, cyber and post-quantum security are recognized as constitutional goods essential to rights, peace and trust.
  2. Critical infrastructures shall be protected against coercive geopolitical use and systemic vulnerability.
  3. Security technologies shall serve protection and cooperation, not domination.

## **TITLE V**

### **ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE AND RESPONSIBILITY**

## **Article 10 – AI as Cognitive Support**

1. Artificial intelligence systems may be used exclusively as tools supporting human analysis and decision-making.
  2. No AI system shall constitute an autonomous source of legal authority or binding decision.

## **Article 11 – Human Accountability**

1. Any decision affecting rights or legitimate interests must be attributable to an identifiable human or institutional subject.
  2. Responsibility for AI-related harm is attributed along the entire technological chain: design, training, validation, deployment, management and use.
  3. The use of AI to evade or dilute human responsibility is prohibited.

## **TITLE VI**

### ROBOTICS IN HUMAN SPACES

#### **Article 12 – Minimum Threshold of Admissibility**

1. Robotic systems operating in proximity to persons in shared spaces are permitted only above a minimum threshold of safety, transparency and human control.
  2. Such threshold includes, at minimum:
    - a) safe shutdown mechanisms;
    - b) clear identification and traceability;
    - c) continuous human override;
    - d) coherence between appearance, communication and real capabilities.

#### **Article 13 – Protection of Human Integrity**

1. The use of robots that pose risks of coercion, manipulation or infringement of fundamental rights is prohibited.
  2. Authorization, audit, public registers and liability regimes shall ensure effective remedies for harm.

## **TITLE VII**

### ECONOMY, FINANCE AND REGENERATION

#### **Article 14 – Regenerative Economy**

1. Economic and financial systems are constitutionally oriented toward shared prosperity, social justice and regeneration.
2. Practices generating systemic destruction, exploitation or war-based profit are incompatible with this Charter.

## **TITLE VIII**

WAR AND PEACE\*\*

**Article 15 – Rejection of War**

1. War is recognized as a negation of human and planetary flourishing.
  2. The Federation commits to the progressive abolition of war as a means of resolving conflicts, promoting prevention, dialogue and cooperation.

**\*\*TITLE IX**

OPEN AND EVOLUTIVE CONSTITUTIONAL ORDER\*\*

**Article 16 – Evolution and Participation**

1. This Charter is open to progressive development through inclusive constitutional processes.
  2. Permanent mechanisms of dialogue shall allow peoples and institutions to contribute to its evolution.

**TITLE X**

ADHESION AND COMMITMENT\*\*

**Article 17 – Open Adhesion**

1. This Charter is open to voluntary adhesion by States, institutions and persons of conscience.
  2. Adhesion constitutes a moral and institutional commitment, without immediate transfer of sovereignty.
- 

**Article 18 – Register of Founding Members and Supporters**

Members are recognized as Founding Supporters of the Constitutional Process and are registered in an official register, maintained with criteria of integrity, transparency and

## FINAL PROVISION

This Constitutional Charter is offered to the world as a foundation for peace, regeneration and flourishing, affirming that only a civilization grounded in dignity, responsibility and care for life can endure and grow.

We, the undersigned,

Recognizing that humanity is going through a historical phase characterized by a profound technological, ecological, economic and cultural transformation;

aware that peace can no longer be understood as the simple absence of war, but as an infrastructure that generates life, stability, cooperation and shared prosperity;

convinced that law, in the age of the technologies of power, must evolve from an instrument of mere defense to an architecture of human and planetary flourishing;

recognizing the centrality of the human person, the dignity of every people, the responsibility towards the Earth as a living good and the duty to regenerate the conditions of life;

inspired by the principles of guaranteeist constitutionalism and the need to extend them to contemporary technological, economic and systemic powers;

### WE SOLEMNLY DECLARE

1. to approve the founding principles of the Federal Constitution Guarantor for the Peace, Regeneration and Flourishing of Humanity;
2. to adhere freely and in conscience to the constitutional process initiated by it, recognizing its moral, legal and institutional value;
3. to subscribe to this Document as the basis for a new path of international cooperation oriented towards peace, justice, the regeneration of the Earth and integral human development;
4. to commit, according to our respective responsibilities and competences, to:
  - to promote the principles of this Constitution;
  - to support the work of the Constitutional Commissions and the Discussion Tables;
  - to promote the ethical, responsible and regenerative use of technologies;
  - to contribute to the construction of a world order based on cooperation and not on war;

5. to recognize that such adhesion constitutes an act of moral and institutional responsibility, open to future developments, in-depth studies and more advanced forms of juridical integration, respecting the freedom, sovereignty and conscience of each member.

With this Declaration, we intend to contribute to the birth of a new paradigm of global coexistence, in which peace is the source of life, regeneration is the engine of prosperity and flourishing represents the shared destiny of humanity and the Earth.
